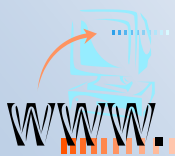

HUSKIES Boys Ball Hockey

On the weekend of April 29 – May 1st the Dorset Boys Ball Hockey Team competed in the SSNL 3A Provincial Tournament in Middle Arm. It was the second straight year that the boys had progressed to the Provincial level; they lost in the semi finals last year. The Huskies opened the tournament against a strong squad from Churchill Falls who had eliminated the Huskies the previous year. The Huskies returned the favour this year kicking off their tournament with a 7-4 victory. They followed this up 7-6 and 6-5 wins over Trepassey and Grand Bank respectively before dropping an 8-2 decision to Glovertown to finish out the round robin with a 3-1 record and a 2nd place finish in their division. More importantly, they were back into the semi-finals against a very strong squad from Flower's Cove who had won their division. The Huskies pushed the pace the entire game, winning battles and keeping up the pressure as they advanced to the finals with a very impressive 7-3 victory. The opponent in the finals was the home town MSB Wildcats, the very team that the Huskies had beaten two weeks previous at the Regional Qualifier to advance to the Provincial Tournament. The Wildcats however would not be denied, taking advantage of a fatigued Husky squad and riding the home town crowd to capture the Provincial title with a 7-0 drubbing of the Huskies. Nick Callahan won the individual sportsmanship award for the Huskies and Mckenzie Roberts and Brady Winsor were named the teams' MVP's.

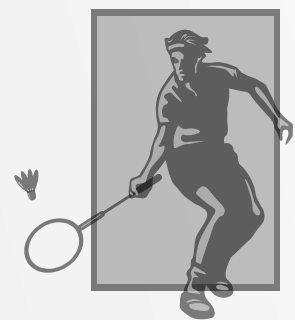
